Large Crowd Present For Colorful Event

Hui Nalu staged an upset yesterday by tying the Outrigger Canoe Club for first place in the Walter J. MacFarlane Memorial canoe races held at the club yesterday.

Each team collected 23 points, followed by the Army with 16; Uunuu, 3, and Junior Civic Club, 1.

The OCC paddlers lost their chance to retain the title they won last year by being disqualified in the senior four-paddle open and boys under 14 events. All crews were disqualified in the relay open, which was won by Hui Nalu. Prizes were awarded but no points were garnered.

A capacity crowd witnessed the colorful races which were under the direction of William J. Mullahey. Meet officials included Duke P. Kahanamoku, coach; Robert Fischer, athletic coordinating chairman, and Neal Iversen, race committee chairman. Starters were Bill Hollinger and Leon Sterling, Jr. Judges were Wilford Godbold, Outrigger president; Jack MacKenzie, John D. Kaupiko, Dr. Blom, Lt. B. Greenwood, Clifford Melim and Mullahey.
