

# Waikiki Surf Club Wins Senior Race

Waikiki Surf Club won the blue ribbon Senior Six Men's event yesterday in the annual Walter J. Macfarlane Memorial canoe regatta at Waikiki Beach.

The Waikiki oarsmen won the four-mile race in 30 minutes 30.1 seconds, defeating Hui Kalia and Hui Nalu, who finished second and third, respectively.

The winning crew was composed of Dutchy Kino, Val Freitas, Blackie Makaena, Moki Perkins, Herbert Bessa, and Wally Froiseth.

In the women's senior six competition, over a one mile course, Waikiki Surf Club, consisting of Violet Makua, Moku Froiseth, Keanue Kekai, Jake Kalama, and Marmie Magoon, with Wally Froiseth as steersman, won in 9 minutes 18.8 seconds. Outrigger was second and Healani third.

The special intercollegiate girls race, a 200-yard sprint was won by a crew composed of students from Stanford, California, Mills, and UCLA. It was a sprint over a 200-yard course.

The freshmen men's race ended in a protest and will be re-raced Sunday morning at 10 o'clock. The outcome of this event is important as Hui Nalu and the Waikiki Surf Club are tied for the lead in the team championship.
