

OCC WINS MACFARLANE RACES

WSC Second In Canoe ^{7/5/52} Regatta _{Adv}

The Outrigger Canoe Club won the annual Fourth of July Walter Macfarlane Memorial canoe racing regatta yesterday on the beach at Waikiki before several thousand spectators.

Winning four first places, a second place, and two third places, the OCC crews scored 25 points to edge out the Waikiki Surf Club which tallied 21 points. Hui Nalu scored 14 points, Koolaupoko seven, and Hui Kalia four.

The men's senior six event over three miles was won by the Waikiki Surf Club in the time of 28 minutes 34.4 seconds. There were five turns during the course of the race.

Members of the crew were George Downing, M. Perkins, G. Young, H. Freitas, D. Kino, and W. Froiseth. Hui Nalu was a close second, Outrigger third, and Hui Kalia fourth.

But the Outrigger Canoe Club came back to win the one mile senior four men's event in 10 minutes 46.2 seconds. Hui Nalu was second in 11.33. Waikiki Surf was third and Hui Kalia fourth.

The winning crew was made up of W. Ackerman, R. Anderson, J. Pflueger, and C. Martin.

Waikiki Surf Club was the winner in the Women's Senior Six in 11 minutes 41 seconds. The race was over one mile with one turn. Gildia Chang, Jake Kalama, Leiola Makaiwi, Carnation Bivins, L. Williams, and Keapue Kekai comprised the winning crew.

OCC was second, with Hui Kalia third.

Waikiki Surf won the girls novice race without paddling when the other club could not enter crews. In the Boys Under 13 event over a quarter mile, Waikiki Surf was the winner in 1 minute 7 seconds. Outrigger was second, when Hui Kalia was disqualified.

The Freshmen Six over one mile saw Outrigger emerge the winner with Waikiki Surf second, Koolaupoko third, and Hui Nalu fourth. The time was 11 minutes 21 seconds.

Hui Nalu copped first place in the half-mile novice boys race in 12 minutes 55 seconds. Waikiki Surf Club was second but was disqualified. Koolaupoko's boat was swamped at the halfway mark.

The Junior Six men event was won by Hui Nalu in 22 minutes 38 seconds, with Waikiki Surf second, OCC third, and Koolaupoko fourth.

With two disqualifications called, the Women's Junior Six event went to Koolaupoko in 14 minutes 38 seconds. Hui Nalu finished first, but was disqualified for cutting in front of another boat, while third place OCC was disqualified for finishing in the wrong lane.

In the Boys Under 17 event, OCC was victorious in 11 minutes 37 seconds. The race was over one mile.

Outrigger captured first honors in the Men's Junior Four in 11 minutes 50 seconds. Waikiki Surf was second in 12:14.
