

LENGTHY CANOE RACE SEASON NEARS END

As this goes to press the canoe racing season nears its end. On Friday, July 23, several chartered plane loads of OCC crews, coaches, officials and rooters fly to Kona for the big Julian Yates Hawaiian Canoe Racing Championships.

Our canoemen did well thus far for the season having annexed second place in all races to date excepting on July 12 when the Club won the Oahu Championships. The Walter Macfarlane Memorial Canoe Races held under the auspices of the Club saw the redoubtable Waikiki Surf Club again take the regatta and win the Blue Ribbon event, the six-man senior race. Without doubt theirs is one of the best senior crews ever to have paddled in modern times.

Our coaches, Bob Bush and Charley Martin, are to be commended on the tireless work and patience, the long hours and skill they have given to coaching. While as a whole our older crews have not won too many firsts the outlook for other years is good as our junior crews have done remarkably well. All members are rooting for the crews, the coaches and all those who helped to keep the sport alive. Win, lose or draw — you've all done well and all honor to our girls and boys, many of whom entered races knowing that chances of winning were slim but who gave everything toward winning points.
