MOLOKAI-OAHU RACES

The Molokai-Oahu outrigger canoe races now in its third year has grown to be an epic event. The races originated by our own "Toots" Minvielle, has never before had an OCC crew entered. However, this year not only a Club crew but a Beach Services crew will enter.

The race starts from the west end of Molokai at Ilio Point at dawn on October 23 and ends at Waikiki Beach immediately in front of the Moana Hotel. Previous races have finished in the afternoon.

The races mark a climax of Aloha Week and are sponsored by Aloha Week Committee and the Hawaii Visitors Bureau.

Prizes will be awarded the winners as follows:

First prize, \$500; second prize, \$300; third prize, \$100; winning crew, gold medals to each paddler and alternates; second place, silver medals to each paddler and alternates; third place, bronze medals to each paddler and alternates.
