

Outrigger is currently tied with Waikiki Surf Club in the men's Molokai-to-Oahu canoe race with 12 wins apiece. The race is billed as the world championship of outrigger canoes by race organizers.

The race begins at 7:30 a.m. at Hale O Lono Harbor on Molokai and the first finisher is expected to arrive at Fort DeRussy Beach in Waikiki before 1 p.m.
