

MARITIME DAY CANOE RACES

The initial races of the 1954 season are past and the Club paddlers did as well as could be expected. Entries were not made in many of the races as the OCC crews are always short of paddlers early in the season. Full complements of crews cannot be expected until the return of many of our best men and women from mainland schools. By the time the Macfarlane races are held on July 4, the Club should be able to fill all seats to compete in the full regatta.

Waikiki Surf Club, with five first places and three seconds, won the team championships in the Maritime Day outrigger canoe races held off Sand Island Sunday, May 23, by the Hawaiian Canoe Racing & Surfing Association.

The WSC paddlers scored 31 points, 10 more than runnerup Hui Nalu. Healani was third with 15 points, followed by Outrigger with nine, Hui Kalia with eight, Kai Ono and Lanikai Canoe Club with five each, and Koolaupoko with three.

Waikiki Surf Club won the men's senior six over three miles, the men's junior six over two miles, the women's senior and junior six over a mile, and the men's senior four over one mile.

Healani won the half mile for boys 15-under and the men's junior four over one mile. Kai Ono took the freshmen six over a mile while Lanikai Canoe Club, making its debut, was awarded first place in the one mile for boys 17 and under when Healani was disqualified for hitting a marker.

Both Waikiki and Healani were disqualified in the freshmen six. The WSC canoe damaged the Hui Nalu canoe while Healani hit the Outrigger boat. Waikiki Surf's time was 8:34½ and Healani's 8:38¾ but Kai Ono was awarded first place.

Only three canoes entered the senior six over a 3-mile course. The Waikiki

Eleven races were held but points did not count in the boys' novice and girls' novice, both over a half mile course. Waikiki Surf won the boys' race and also the girls' event.
