OCC PADDLERS OUTSTANDING IN HILO RACES

On August 4, our OCC paddlers went forth with high hopes which were amply justified. Trained by veteran paddler George Downing, brought along slowly with the Duke P. Kahanamoku Territorial Championships in view, they put forth their best—which was slightly less than good enough.

The final results hinged on the three mile six man senior blue ribbon event. OCC came in second to the doughty Waikiki Surf Club scoring three points against the Waikiki Surf Club's five points, making a total of OCC 34 points—Waikiki Surf Club 37. But, this does not tell the story—as the distance between the canoes at the end was less than a length and it points to the OCC in 1957 being the contender to beat.

All our young paddlers did well as the results below testify.

Other results of the continuously rain-drenched regatta were:

Kai Oni, 14; Hui Nalu, 11; Hilo, 9;

Kauai, 7; Healani, 5; Holomua, 2; at Kamehameha (Hilo), 1.

The Outrigger group set two records, and Waikiki Surf and Kai Oni broke one apiece, as follows:

Senior (6) women's half-mile, won by Outrigger Canoe Club in 5:00.1, which was 1 second better than the old record of 5:12.9.

Junior (4) men's one-mile, won by Kai Oni in 8:44.09, which was 4.71 seconds better than the 8:48.8 record set by Hui Nalu.

Junior (6) women's half-mile, won by Outrigger Canoe Club in 4:52.0, which was 3.1 seconds better than the record they set early this year, 4:55.1.

Girls' (6) novice half-mile was won by Waikiki Surf in 5:07.02, which was about 28 seconds better than the record they set earlier this year, 5:35.4.

Kauai, entering a Territorial regatta for the first time, pleased the crowd with a fine showing, which included second place in the boys' novice half-mile race, and two third-place victories.
