## **OUTRIGGER PADDLERS WIN TITULAR CANOE REGATTA**

LIHUE, Kauai — The Outrigger Canoe Club of Honolulu, coached by George Downing, scored 36 points to capture the 1958 Territorial canoe racing championship at Nawiliwili Harbor.

An estimated 2,000 persons braved high winds and rain to take in the 10-event program which honored John D. Kaupiko, Sr., veteran Hui Nalu coach and canoe racing enthusiast.

The OCC paddlers placed first in four events and also finished in second place four times. Two other OCC crews finished in third place in their respective events.

Waikiki Surf, which took the men's senior six two-mile blue ribbon event, was second in the team standings with 24 points. Kai Oni followed with 18 and Kai Opua of Kona, Hawaii, was third with 8. Following were Kauai and Lanikai with 7 each, Healani 6, Hui Nalu 3 and Hui Kalia 1.

Waikiki's winning crew in the two-mile race was made up of Dutchy Kino, Moses Perkins, Conrad Canha, Rodney Botelho, Blackie Makaena and Blue Makua. The winning time was 15:02.3.

Outrigger's victory gave Downing's club its fourth straight canoe championship this year.

All times turned in established records for the course. This marked the first time Kauai has held the Territorial championships.

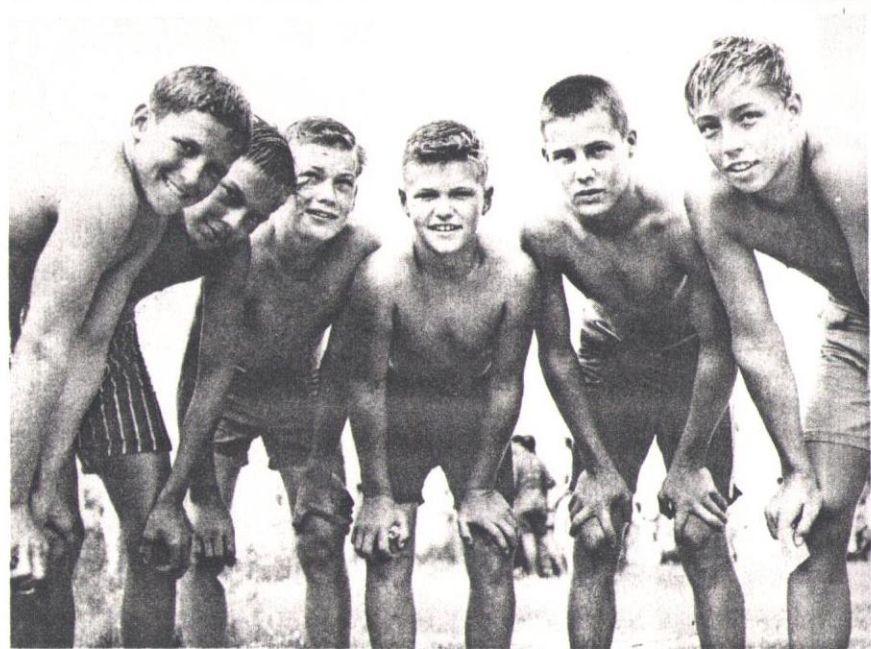
The races were conducted by the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association with Paul Jones in charge of the race committee.

Awards were presented last night at a banquet at Kauai Inn.

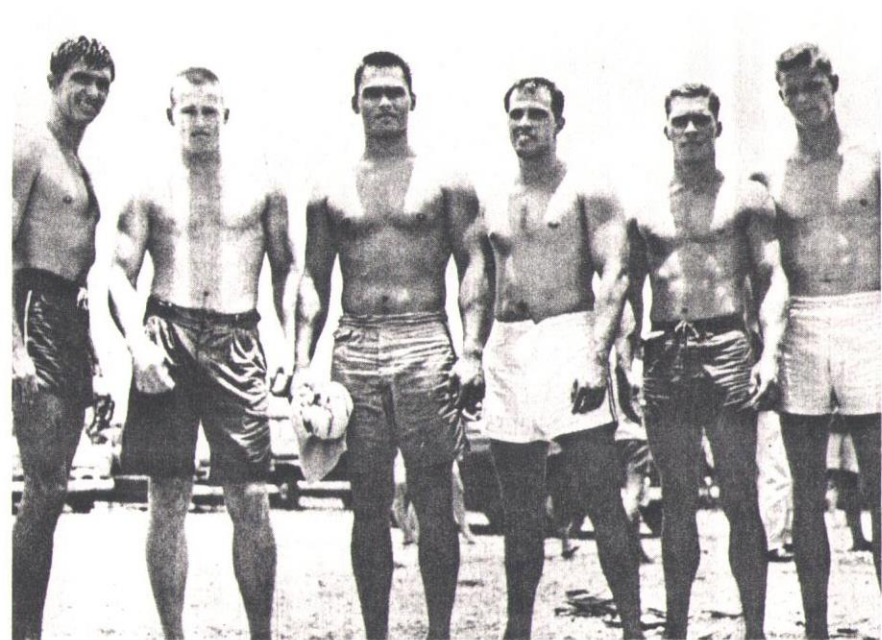
