Outrigger's Boy's 16s, Sophomore, Junior, Senior and Senior Masters Men remained undefeated in three outings.

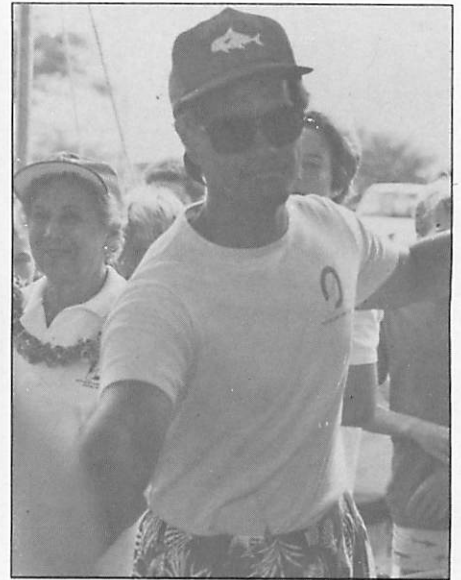

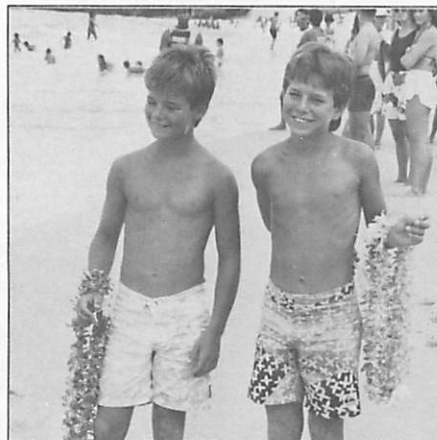

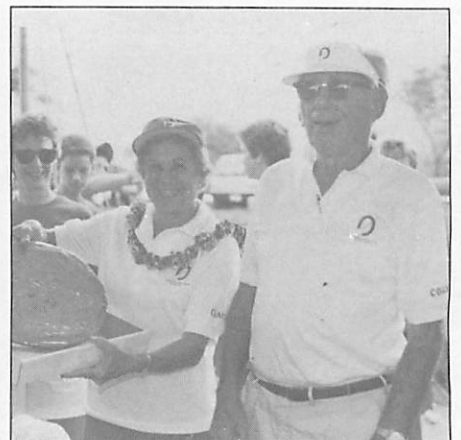

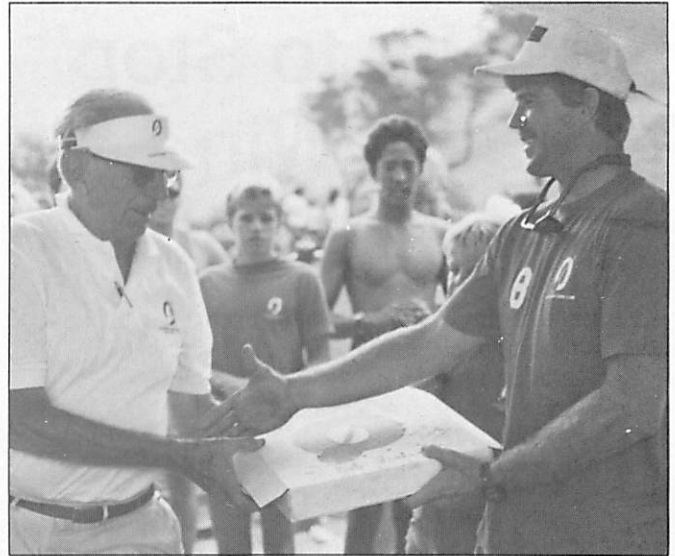
