Olympic hopeful Ted Crane took second overall among 600 competitors from 13 countries in the SPORT (St. Petersburg Olympic Race Training) Regatta completed in late March in Florida. Helmsman Crane and Trapeze Woody Cox beat out all United States Tornado sailors to emerge from the same competition as North American Tornado Champions. Representing the OCC, Crane and Cox went into the Florida competition after taking seventh in the World's Tornado Championships held in Sydney, Australia the second week in February. According to Crane, only one U.S. Tornado crew will sail for a gold medal in the summer Olympic games. Two alternate crews will stand by. Final Olympic trails will be held on Lake Ontario June 8-19.... The Molokai-to-Oahu
