

OCC Sailors take State Hobie 14 Championship Honors

OCC skipper Mike Holmes, accumulating the most points in a season of 20 regattas, took top honors in the 7th Hawaii Hobie 14 Season which ended with the State Championship regatta over the weekend of August 7-8 in Kaneohe Bay. Dale Hope took second spot in season-points.

Harold Hutchings, OCC sailing committee chairman, came in second in that final championship regatta. (Dean Froome, Hawaii Hobie-Cat Association member, took first place.)

Both Holmes and Hope are thus among five Hawaii skippers qualified to enter the National Hobie 14 Championships at Dana Point, California, September 29-October 2. (Others are Froome, Howard Lynn and Dave Lung, HHCA members.)

The Hawaii State Season and Championship regattas are sponsored annually by HHCA, a member organization of the National Hobie Class Association.
