

# Aussie Wins Ocean Ironman

Trevor Hendy, a professional triathlete from Australia, won the Coppertone Ocean Ironman Hawaiian Championships, May 13 at Sans Souci Beach. The event was co-sponsored by OCC and produced by Gentry Sports.

The event included a 2K paddleboard race, .6K beach run, .8K swim, .6K beach run and a 2.6K surfski race.

The race was extremely close with less than a minute separating the first, second and third finishers. Hendy's time was 59 minutes, 19 seconds. Behind him were Hawaii lifeguard Chris Moore in 1:00:07 and Los Angeles

triathlete Craig Hummer, 1:00:09.

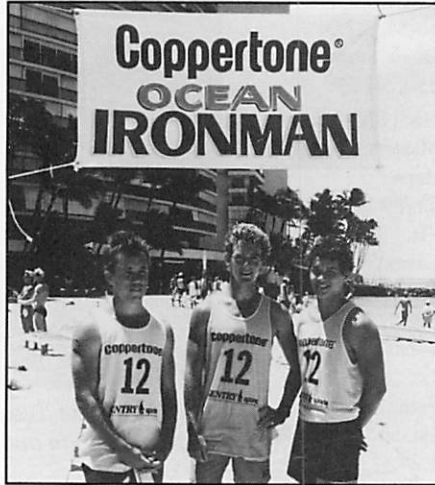
Hendy was first at the end of the paddleboard, followed by Moore. At the end of the swim, they had switched places, with the Aussie pulling ahead in the surfski.

The biggest surprises of the day came from Jr. 'Riggers Wyatt Jones and Malia Kamisugi. Wyatt was the first amateur to finish, in sixth place overall, in 1:08:56 and Malia was 12th overall, winning the women's competition in 1:17:07.

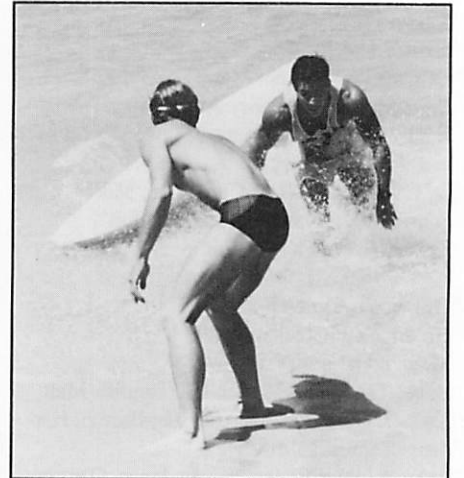

Malia Kamisugi won the women's competition and Wyatt Jones was top amateur.



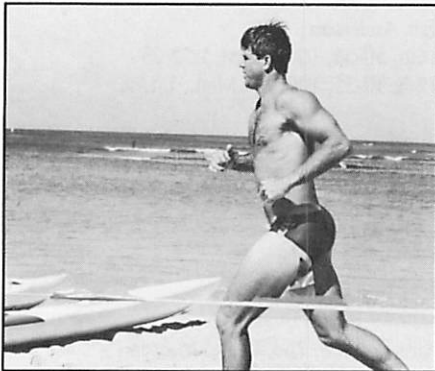
The top Junior relay team was Todd Duplanty, Nalu Kukea and Brad Yim.



Ian Moore races to swimmer Rick Heltzel in relay.



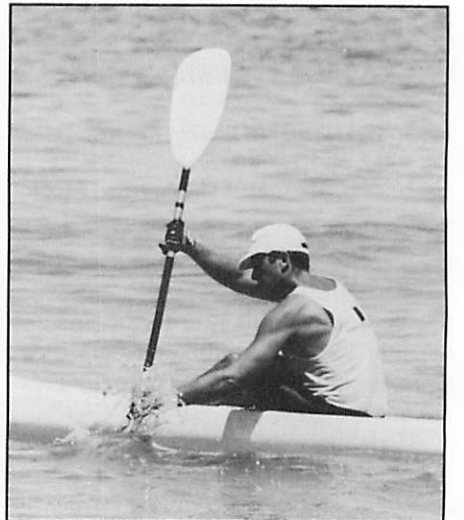

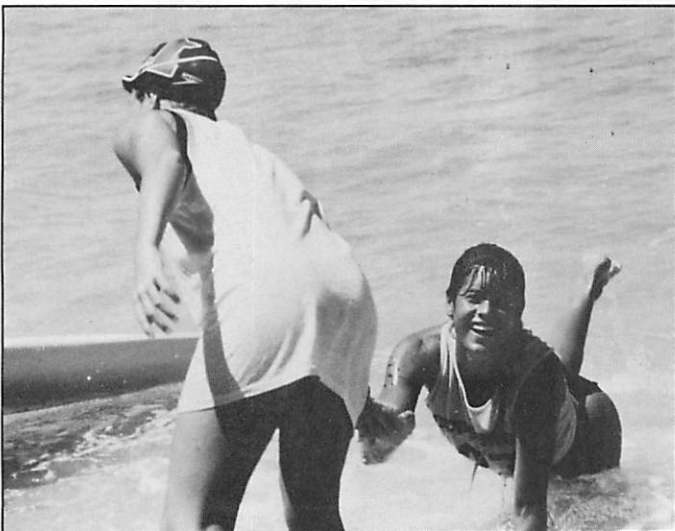
