

# Mountainball All-Stars

The first annual Surveyors Mountainball League All-Star game was played July 3 at the Elks Field. Named to the "A" team all-stars from the OCC were Archie Kaaua, coach; Bill Head, pitcher; Colin Chock, catcher; Danny West, shortstop; Peter Balding, second base; Hank Ayau, first base. Also named to the team but unable to play were Bill Breeden, left field; and Bill Erickson, short center.
