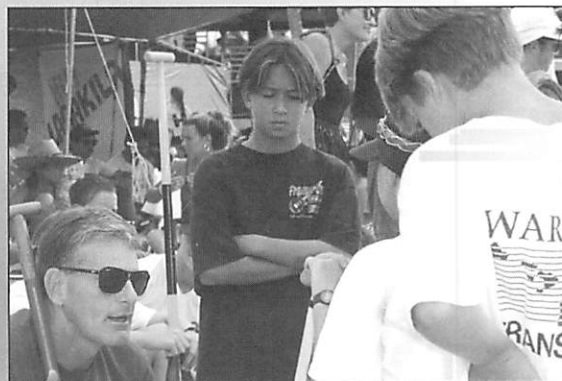

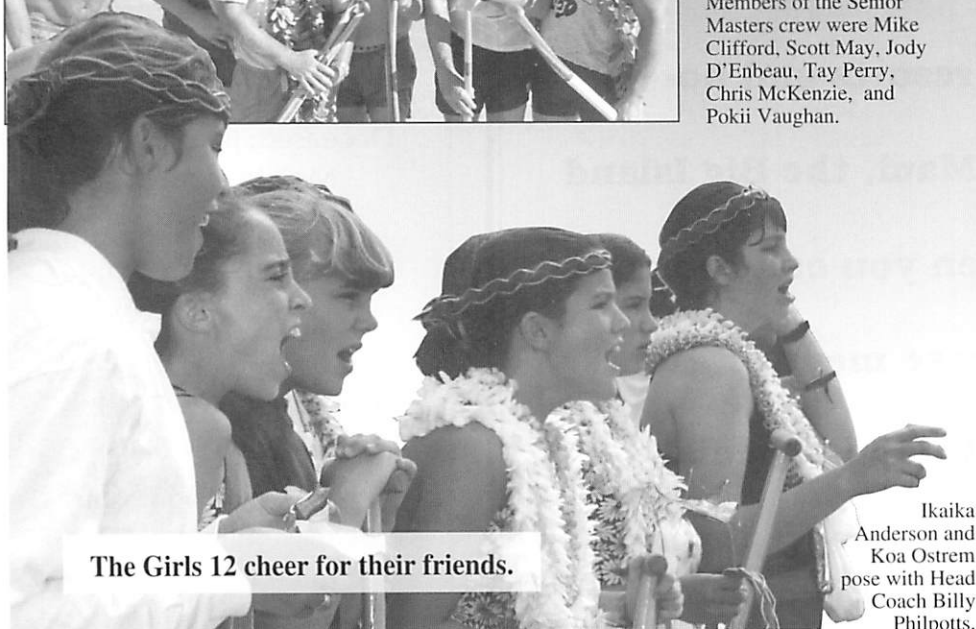


Coach Bill Bright gives his crew some pre-race strategy.

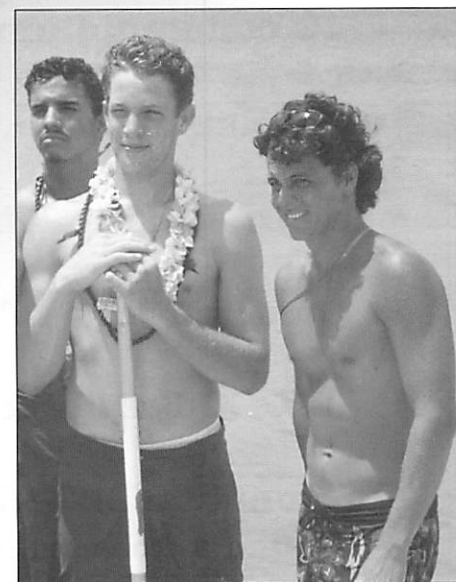
