

Outrigger Third in Leeward Kai, Waimanalo Regatta

Outrigger paddlers gave it their all at the Leeward Kai Regatta on June 21 at Nanakuli Beach Park and the Waimanalo Regatta at Waimanalo Beach Park on June 28, finishing third in both regattas.

Despite OCC winning eight events, Lanikai won the Leeward Regatta with 71 points, followed by Kailua with 59 and Outrigger following with 51.

At Waimanalo, Kailua won its first regatta of the season with 81 points, followed by Lanikai with 72 and Outrigger with 54. Outrigger won six races.

Outrigger's Boys 18's are undefeated after four regattas.
