DQ's were the story of the day during the Leeward Kai Regatta at Nanakuli Beach on June 18, and combined with scratches in 12 of the events, Outrigger's 43 points were hard to come by. Lanikai won the regatta with 75 points, followed by Kailua with 65. Hui Nalu was third with 48 points and OCC and Hui Lanakila tied for 4th with 43.

With a strong current ripping through the turn areas and generally rough conditions overall, there were many crew disqualifications for hitting the flag or finishing in the wrong lane.

OCC's Boys and Girls 14s remained undefeated, and the Masters Women 54 won their event. Outrigger scored points in 19 of the 35 races including two seconds, eight thirds and six fourths.

In the Waimanalo Regatta on June 25 at Waimanalo Beach Park, Outrigger also finished fourth behind Kailua, Lanikai and Hui Nalu, scoring 46 points.

Outrigger again won the Boys and Girls 14s races, placed second in seven events, third in five events, and fourth in five races.
