Regatta Season is Upon Us Again!

For those who paddled during the 2005 regatta season, it probably seems like yesterday when you last raced in Keehi Lagoon, or practiced turns in the Ala Wai. But nearly six months have flown by and here we are again- registration is upon us; recruitment for coaches and paddlers are in full-swing; and your Canoe Racing Subcommittee has already started preparing for the 2006 regatta season!

Registration for the 2006 regatta season begins Saturday, March 11, and the last day to register and grab the cheaper "Early Bird Special" is Saturday, April 22.

If you register on or before April 22, you will SAVE \$50! It's only \$75 per paddler up through April 22; it will cost \$125 per paddler after April 22.

Both Saturday registrations will be held in the Board Room at the Club between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

For our new paddlers and those who were not registered in 2005, please make sure you bring a copy of your birth certificate, and remember you need your own OCC membership number.

If you are new or are returning after time away from the program,

you also need to bring a smile-you'll need to get a digital picture taken during registration. For our 2005 registered paddlers, you can fill out registration forms at the Front Desk or you can also download them on the website at www.outriggercanoecub.com.
