OCC paddlers completed the 2013 regatta season by finishing third in the Oahu Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Championships on July 21 at Keehi Lagoon and fourth in the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association Championships on August 3 at Hanalei Bay, Kauai.

Junior crews turned in impressive performances all season, with the Boys 18s winning both Oahu's and States. The Girls 16s went undefeated during the OHCRA season, and finished second in States. The Boys 15s also won Oahu's and were second in States.

Also winning a Gold medal in States were the Men 60s, who had a stellar season.

The koa canoe *Leilani* made her triumphant return to canoe racing at the OHCRA championship at Keehi Lagoon. The Boys 18s carried her to the water and paddled to the starting line. The *Leilani* was first off the start and never trailed during her half mile race. The 80-year-old canoe is ready for her next decade of racing.

The Paddler's Banquet was held on July 29 in the Koa Lanai.

Former Canoe Racing Chair and Club Captain Jenifer Bossert received a special trophy from the Canoe Racing

Committee for her 10-year commitment to modernizing the Club's three koa racing canoes and bring them into compliance with HCRA rules. The base of the trophy was made from old koa removed from the *Leilani* during her renovation. The trophy was made "with love" by Domie Gose who remodeled the canoes.

Also honored at the banquet were four junior paddlers who were recognized for their outstanding service and paddling during the 2013 regatta season. Kiana Sandvold, Kiele Schwinn, Riggs Silva and Alex Wallen were the recipients of the Bob Fischer Award.

The men and women who devoted so much of their time to coaching the OCC crews were also recognized, as were members of the Canoe Racing Committee.

Outrigger won the Macfarlane Regatta, finished third in the Paiaina, Father's Day, Kaupiko and OHCRA regattas, and fourth in the Kamehameha, Waimanalo and HCRA championships.

Next up for the paddlers are the Molokai races: the Na Wahine O Ke Kai on September 22 and the Molokai Hoe on October 6.
