## Coach Will Be Missed — Given Credit For Punahou's Victory In Interscholastic

Percy Nottage, coach of the championship Punahou basketball team of 1920 will leave for the mainland Wednesday where he will spend several months. He expects to return to Hawaii.

Nottage will be missed in basketball circles here as he was a live wire in the Interscholastic and the A. A. U. leagues, which was demonstrated when the Puns won the Interscholastic championship. Nottage also coached the Outrigger teams and played on its senior five.

Members of the Punahou team give all credit to Nottage in developing a winning team this year and allege that it was due to his interest and patience last year that a winning team was finally developed. This championship is the first one taken by Punahou and the students are pleased with Nottage's work. He developed a fast team with many varieties of play and with the best team-work that has been seen in the islands. There is a great array of talent on the team and most of the boys in the squad received their training under Nottage. The Puns will enter the Island championship series.

Nottage also played and coached the Outrigger team and in the game that he played he starred for the Canoemen. He caged six field goals in spite of his long layoff from the game. The Outrigger has one of the fastest teams in the A. A. U. League and it is due largely to Nottage's work that it is where it is now. He developed several stars and although he will not be here during the balance of the season, his training should bear fruit.

Nottage is an old-timer in athletics here, having established several records in the mile and the half-mile runs in the Interscholastic league when he was a student of Punahou. He will be greatly missed by the Punahou boys and the Outrigger club teams.
