

SECOND PEG HONORS ARE THE STAKE FOR BASKET

Race To Place As Runners Up Is Getting Hotter With the Officers In Lead

With the win Monday night of the Outrigger basket five there is little desperate opposition in sight for that team at present, and the contest in the local league has resolved itself into a battle for second place honors, chiefly between the Officers team from Schofield, the National Guard and the Schofield Service Club. These three are not too evenly listed in the standings at that and it would appear, at present, that the Schofield Officers will have the honor of meeting the Los Angeles Blues as runners up in the league here, while the Schofield Service Club, as the military organization having highest place exclusive of the first two teams, will probably take on the visitors as well.

Tonight's games place the Guard against the Honolulu Amateur Athletic Club; the Luke Field team against the Schofield Officers; and the Kamehameha five against the Schofield Service Club. The Guard, Officers and Schofields should all win, if there is no reversal of general form, and the race for second honors will in this case remain in status quo.
